  - b. Utilize free bulky item pick up, limit two items per year. Call for pricing beyond the two free items, 685-4711
  - c. Take items to the Contra Costa Transfer & Recovery Station for a fee. Accepts household trash, recycling offered for green waste, mattresses, large appliances, electronic waste.
